ID REQUIREMENTS AT THE POLLS

For the first time, voters will have to provide identification (ID) to vote.

Acceptable ID may include:

- ★ a government photo ID (Ohio driver's license or state ID showing either your current address or your former address, as long as the ID has not expired),
- ★ a military identification that shows your name and current address,
- ★ a copy of a current utility bill,
- ★ bank statement,
- ★ government check,
- ★ paycheck, or
- ★ other government document that shows your name and current address

You **cannot** use the voter registration notification card you will be receiving from the Board of Elections.

Other requirements you should know:

- ★ Photo ID issued by a private company, organization or college will NOT be accepted. Your photo ID must be government-issued.
- ★ The name shown on your ID must conform to the name in the poll book;
- ★ The address shown must be your current address and conform to the address in the poll book, with the exception of a driver's license or state ID that shows a former address if the license or state ID has not expired.
