2022 Plans for the Redistricting/Fair Elections Committee

- To keep this topic front and center in the minds of the LWVGD membership, we are planning a series of public education redistricting programs after the proposed late summer primary and before the general election November 8.
- We will use library facilities around the county including Dayton Metropolitan Public Library and five of its branches; the Washington-Centerville Public Library's Woodbourne site; and Greene County Public Library branches in Beavercreek and Xenia.
- Programs will be held in late September and early October as voters begin to consider early voting.
- We will utilize the expertise of League members to create a panel to discuss the history of gerrymandering; a recap of the 2021 process; and the impact of the adopted maps on our neighborhoods.
- We will take direction from the State League as to the need to again collect signatures to amend the State Constitution and create as outlined by Chief Justice Maureen O'Connor, "a truly independent, nonpartisan commission that more effectively distances the redistricting process from partisan politics."
