NEW VOTER ID REQUIREMENTS

To vote in person, you must have a Government Photo ID

- Drivers license OR-
- State ID card OR-
- Passport

If you don't have a government photo ID, you can still vote ABSENTEE.

- 1. Get an application form. Call the Board of Elections at (937)225-5656 to have an application mailed to you or go to <u>Montgomery County Board of Elections</u> to download the form.
- 2. Fill out the form. You will need the last 4 numbers of your Social Security Number. <u>Be sure to sign the form.</u>
- 3. Return the form to the Board of Elections by April 25, 2023 for the May 2 election.
- 4. When you get your ballot, follow the directions to mark your choices.
- 5. Put your ballot in the Identification Envelope, fill in the information needed, and <u>SIGN THE ENVELOPE.</u>
- 6. Seal the Identification and put it inside the return envelope.
- 7. Mail the ballot by Monday, May 1, or take it to the Board of Elections by 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 2.
