# LOCAL BALLOT ISSUES MONTGOMERY COUNTY

This list includes all the ballot issues for Montgomery County. Each issue applies to a specific community or school district. Your ballot will have only the issues for your community or school district.

### **Issue 1: City of Brookville (Precinct A) Local Option**

This issue would allow the sale of wine and mixed beverages on Sundays at Casey's General Store #4402, 945 Arlington Road, Brookville, OH.

### Issue 2: City of Centerville (Precinct N) Local Option

This issue would allow the sale of beer by the package in the precinct.

#### **Issue 3: City of Centerville (Precinct N) Local Option**

This issue would allow the sale of wine and mixed beverages by the package for carryout. It would also allow state liquor stores or liquor agency stores to sell liquor by the package for carryout.

## **Issue 4: City of Clayton Zoning Vote**

This issue would approve a change in zoning to allow the Salem Springs housing development to be built on the east side of Haber Road and south side of Phillipsburg-Union Road.

## **Issue 5: City of Clayton Income Tax**

This issue would raise the city income tax by 1%. It would restore the 100% credit for income taxes paid to other cities, so some people would not have a tax increase. The additional money would be used for general operations and functions of the city.

#### **Issue 6: City of Dayton Income Tax**

This issue would renew the ½% additional income tax approved by voters in 2016. The money would be used for public safety, road repairs, vacant lot maintenance, high-quality preschool, and housing investments. This issue **would not increase** taxes.

#### **Issue 7: City of Dayton (Precinct 2-B) Local Option**

This issue would allow the sale of beer, wine, mixed drinks, and liquor at Local 937 LLC, 1501 E Fifth Street, Dayton, OH. It includes both regular and Sunday sales.

#### **Issue 8: City of Kettering (Precinct 2-J) Local Option**

This issue would allow the sale of beer, wine, mixed drinks, and liquor on Sundays at Eudora Brewing Co LLC, 3022 Wilmington Pike, Kettering, OH.

### **Issue 9: City of Oakwood Current Expense Levy**

This issue would raise the property tax to provide money to pay the city's expenses. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by about \$85 a year.

## Issue 10: City of Riverside Police Levy

This issue would keep the same tax rate to provide money for operating the police department. It **would increase** property taxes taxes for the average homeowner by about \$44 a year.

## Issue 11: Butler Township (Precinct A) Local Option

This issue would allow the sale of beer, wine, mixed drinks, and liquor on Sundays at Spirits Tavern LLC, 11419 N. Dixie Dr., Butler Twp, Vandalia, OH.

#### **Issue 12: German Township, including the City of Germantown**

This issue would keep the same tax rate to provide money for operating and maintaining the Germantown Union Cemetery. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by less than \$10.

#### **Issue 13: Harrison Township Current Expense Levy**

This issue would start a new tax to provide money to pay the township's expenses. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by about \$175 a year.

#### Issue 14: Harrison Township Fire and EMS Levy

This issue would increase the tax rate to provide money for the fire department to buy equipment, pay staff, and provide firefighting and emergency medical services for the township. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by about \$175 a year.

## **Issue 15: Jackson Township South Fire District**

This issue would keep the same tax rate to provide money for the fire department to buy equipment, pay staff, and provide firefighting and emergency medical services for the district. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by about \$29 a year.

## **Issue 16: Jefferson Township (Precinct C) Local Option**

This issue would allow the sale of beer, wine, mixed drinks, and liquor on Sundays at Beverage Dock, 7208 Germantown Pike, Miamisburg, OH.

## <u>Issue 17: Miami Township Police Levy</u>

This issue would keep the same tax rate to provide money for the Miami Township Police Department to buy equipment, pay staff, and provide police protection for the parts of Miami Township that are not in the City of Miamisburg. It **would not increase** property taxes.

#### **Issue 18: Centerville City School District**

This issue would start a new tax to provide money to keep the schools running in the Centerville school district. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by about \$135 a year.

#### Issue 19: Brookville Local School District

This issue would continue a tax to provide money to keep the schools running in the Brookville Local school district. It **would not increase** property taxes.

#### Issue 20: Brookville Local School District

This issue would continue a tax to provide money for school buildings in the Brookville Local school district. It **would not increase** property taxes.

# <u>Issue 21: Warren County Career Center (Carlisle Local School District)</u>

This issue would let the school district borrow money to build new building and fix up older school buildings, and to buy furniture and equipment for the schools. It **would increase** property taxes for the average homeowner by about \$30 a year.
